



Master Certificate in the Dorn Method

To become Master certified in the Dorn Method the student must be able to demonstrate advanced skills in the Dorn Method after completing both level 1 and Advanced courses held by the DMAA.

Students selected for the master's level must undergo assessment by Dr Jason Mallia Master instructor to enter the masters clinical study. Students must demonstrate a thorough understanding of the techniques and its application in clinical practice.

Once selected students are asked to enrol and complete the following:

- 100 cases in clinic using the Dorn Method (proof required of consultation)
- 10 written case studies demonstrating Dorn and its outcome in treatment
- 1 x 10-20 Min Video must be submitted demonstrating the technique or this can be done in person with Dr Jason Mallia
- Attendance of 1-2 Dorn Trainings either Level 1 or Advanced (please note if students tick all of the above requirements this may not be compulsory).

Once the above criteria has been met a Masters Certificate will be issued and you will join the alumni of the DMAA. Students are then invited to become Master instructors upon approval by the Board of Directors of the DMAA.
